Background

This NERC Standards NOW! online course is delivered through <u>Spark! By OES-NA</u>. The course is intended to provide system personnel with an explanation and understanding of the NERC IRO Standards. The course steps through each of the 9 standards. Each lesson is culminated with a standard review and quiz. Upon completion of the 9 standard lessons, there is a final assessment that consists of multiple-choice questions. Individuals must attain a passing grade of 70% on the final assessment in order to be awarded the NERC CEHs.

IRO Standards Review

This online course steps through 9 lessons related to the 9 IRO Standards. Each lesson identifies and explains the Purpose, Applicability, Requirements, Measures, Compliance, and Violation Severity Levels elements for that particular standard. The Standards addressed include:

- IRO-002-5 Monitoring and Analysis
- IRO-006-5 Transmission Loading Relief
- IRO-008-2 Reliability Coordinator Operational Analyses and Real-time Assessm
- IRO-009-2 Reliability Coordinator Actions to Operate Within IROLs
- IRO-010-2 Reliability Coordinator Data Specification and Collection
- IRO-014-3 Coordination Among Reliability Coordinators
- IRO-017-1 Outage Coordination
- IRO-018-1i Reliability Coordinator Real-time Reliability Monitoring and Analysis Capabilities

Delivery Schedule

Because the course is delivered on an individual basis via the Internet, individuals have the ability to set their own pace and schedule for completion of the course. Registered students are provided with 12 months from the time of registration to complete the course.

Student Requirements

- Students must sign-in using their individual log-in and password to access the course.
- Students are required to provide their NERC SO Certification # and other applicable contact information during the course registration process.
- Students must complete all course material prior to attempting the final assessment.
- Students must successfully earn a 70% grade on the final activity assessment.
